Improvement systems depend on people volunteering information about problems, which they will only do under specific conditions. This course covers creating those conditions. Delegates work through engagement in improvement, capability building at the front line, the design of suggestion and problem raising mechanisms that actually get used, recognition, and the handling of the resistance that follows any previous programme that cost people jobs. The material is practical and grounded in what supervisors and managers can influence directly, with attention to sustaining involvement past the initial enthusiasm.
