Blockchain and Web3 in E-Government

Course overview

Public sector interest in distributed ledgers centres on registries, identity and the auditability of public records. This course examines those applications for African public administration specifically. Delegates cover land and asset registries, credential and qualification verification, digital identity and its governance, procurement transparency, and the public record keeping obligations a ledger interacts with. The course is direct about the preconditions: a ledger cannot fix a registry whose underlying records are contested, and digitising a broken process produces a faster broken process. Governance, procurement and the long term cost of running the infrastructure receive as much attention as the technology.

What you will learn

- Assess registry, identity and credential use cases in public administration
- Identify the data quality preconditions a ledger initiative depends on
- Design governance for a public sector network, including who may write to it
- Address public record keeping and archival obligations
- Evaluate procurement transparency applications realistically
- Plan for the long term operating cost and institutional ownership of the infrastructure
