Decision Rules and Statements of Conformity

2 day course

Classroom, online or in-house

Course overview

When a laboratory states that a result passes or fails a specification, it has made a decision about a measurement that carries uncertainty, and the rule governing that decision has to be agreed with the customer before the work starts. This course covers those rules. Delegates work through simple acceptance, guard banding and the shared and specific risk approaches, calculate the probability of a false accept and a false reject, and select a rule proportionate to the consequence of getting it wrong. The customer conversation is treated as part of the method, since a decision rule imposed after a result is a dispute waiting to happen. The course closes on wording a conformity statement that says exactly what was decided.

What you will learn

- Explain why a conformity statement is a decision under uncertainty
- Apply simple acceptance, guard banding and risk based decision rules
- Calculate the probability of a false accept and a false reject
- Select a rule proportionate to the consequence of a wrong decision
- Agree a decision rule with a customer before work begins
- Word a conformity statement so it says exactly what was decided
- Handle a result that falls inside the guard band
