Most digital transformation programmes deliver technology and fail to change how work is done, which is the only part that was ever going to produce a return. This course concentrates on the second. Delegates work through building a transformation case tied to business outcomes, assessing current state honestly including the legacy estate nobody wants to discuss, and sequencing change so early delivery funds and justifies later work. Operating model, capability and the organisational resistance that follows any redistribution of control are treated as the core of the work. The course closes on benefits realisation and on the reporting that distinguishes progress from activity.

- Sequence change so early delivery justifies later investment
- Design the operating model the technology requires
- Build the capability needed to sustain the change
