Course overview

A course for people who work in or around the electricity supply industry without an electrical engineering background, and who need to understand what the technical staff are discussing. Delegates cover the physical basics of electricity, how generation, transmission and distribution fit together, the main plant items and what each does, why the system must be balanced continuously, and the causes of outages and constraints. The commercial layer is covered as well: how electricity is traded and priced, what a tariff is built from, and how regulation shapes the sector. No mathematics beyond arithmetic is required, and the emphasis throughout is on being able to follow and question a technical conversation.

- Explain voltage, current, power and energy in practical terms
- Describe how generation, transmission and distribution fit together
- Identify the main plant items and the function of each
- Explain why supply and demand must be balanced continuously
- Describe the common causes of outages and network constraints
- Outline how electricity is priced and what a tariff is built from
- Follow and question a technical discussion with confidence
