Energy Management Systems and ISO 50001 Implementation

Course overview

A structured energy management system turns energy saving from a series of projects into a permanent capability. This course covers the implementation of one to the ISO 50001 standard. Delegates work through the requirements clause by clause, establish an energy review and baseline, define energy performance indicators that survive changes in production volume, set objectives and action plans, and design the measurement, monitoring and verification that demonstrate a saving is real. Internal audit and management review are covered, along with the practical problem that defeats most systems: attributing a change in consumption correctly when production, weather and product mix all moved at the same time.

What you will learn

- Interpret the requirements of ISO 50001 and their practical implications
- Conduct an energy review and establish a defensible baseline
- Define energy performance indicators that hold under changing production
- Set objectives, targets and action plans that are actually achievable
- Design measurement, monitoring and verification for claimed savings
- Attribute consumption change correctly when several variables moved
- Plan internal audit and management review of the system
