Course overview

Moving goods across borders introduces documentation, duty, currency and delay that domestic logistics never faces, and a mistake in any of them stops a shipment somewhere expensive. This course covers international distribution. Delegates work through incoterms and what each actually transfers, the documentation set that governs a shipment, and customs, duty and preferential trade agreements including those operating across African markets. Freight forwarding, consolidation and mode selection for international movement follow. The course covers landed cost calculation and closes on distribution network design across borders, including where inventory should sit given the lead times actually experienced.

What you will learn

- Apply incoterms correctly and know what each transfers
- Assemble the documentation set governing an international shipment
- Handle customs, duty and preferential trade agreements
- Select and manage freight forwarders
- Consolidate shipments and choose international modes
- Calculate true landed cost
- Design a cross border network and decide where inventory sits
