Green Hydrogen Financial Modelling, Oil and Gas Fiscal Regimes, and ESG Reporting

3 day course

Course overview

Namibia has become one of Africa's most active energy investment destinations, with significant offshore oil and gas discoveries alongside world leading green hydrogen initiatives. This intensive three day course gives participants the practical tools to evaluate green hydrogen projects, work through Namibia's petroleum fiscal framework, and implement internationally recognised ESG reporting practices. Delegates build project financial models, calculate net present value, internal rate of return, payback period and the levelised cost of hydrogen, and analyse royalties, taxation, state participation and government take. The ESG component covers the major global disclosure frameworks and how to align sustainability reporting with investor expectations. The programme closes with an integrated capstone covering a hydrogen export model, an offshore fiscal evaluation and an investment committee recommendation.

What you will learn

- Evaluate the economics of green hydrogen production and export projects and build financial models for them
- Calculate net present value, internal rate of return, payback period and levelised cost of hydrogen, with scenario and sensitivity analysis
- Analyse Namibia's petroleum legal, regulatory and fiscal framework including royalties, taxation and state participation
- Assess project profitability under different fiscal scenarios and compare Namibia's competitiveness with other African jurisdictions
- Apply global ESG disclosure frameworks and develop reporting strategies aligned with investor requirements
- Measure and report environmental, social and governance performance indicators
- Integrate ESG considerations into investment and financing decisions

- 06 Day 2: petroleum economics workshop, production forecasting, cost recovery and government take analysis
- 07 Day 2: comparative fiscal analysis against Angola, Mozambique, South Africa, Botswana and Ghana
- 08 Day 3: ESG fundamentals for the energy sector, sustainable finance, climate risk and the energy transition
- 09 Day 3: ESG reporting frameworks including the Global Reporting Initiative, ISSB, TCFD and SASB standards
- 10 Day 3: ESG performance measurement, carbon accounting, materiality assessment and green finance instruments
- 11 Day 3: integrated capstone project and investment committee presentation
