Course overview

An underground cable fault is invisible, expensive and slow to repair, and most are caused during installation rather than by the cable itself. This course covers specification through to fault location. Delegates work through cable construction and insulation types, sizing against current rating and the installation conditions that derate it, and the specification of joints and terminations. Installation practice receives detailed attention, including bending radius, pulling tension and the handling errors that seed a fault years later. Commissioning tests and partial discharge measurement are covered, along with jointing and termination technique. The course closes on fault location methods and the repair decision on an ageing circuit.

What you will learn

- Specify cable construction and insulation type for a duty
- Size cable against current rating and installation derating factors
- Specify joints and terminations appropriate to the system
- Apply installation practice including bending radius and pulling tension
- Carry out commissioning tests and partial discharge measurement
- Locate a fault using the available methods
- Decide between repair and replacement on an ageing circuit
