Lean Logistics for Supply Chain Operations

Course overview

This course applies lean principles across a supply chain rather than within a single facility. Delegates work through end to end value stream mapping, transport and network design, cross docking and consolidation, milk runs and delivery frequency, and the inventory that exists purely to cover variability elsewhere in the chain. The course addresses the specific realities of African logistics: long and variable lead times, border delays, infrastructure constraints and the buffer these genuinely require, and is direct about which lean techniques transfer to that environment and which do not.

What you will learn

- Map an end to end supply chain value stream
- Design transport networks and delivery frequency
- Apply cross docking and consolidation appropriately
- Identify inventory held purely to cover variability elsewhere
- Reduce lead time and its variability
- Assess which lean techniques transfer to long and variable lead times
- Build the buffer that African logistics conditions genuinely require
