Course overview

An extended programme for those who will lead improvement projects and coach others. Delegates work through the full method with the statistical depth that distinguishes a black belt: measurement system analysis, capability studies, hypothesis testing, regression, designed experiments and control strategy. Equal weight is given to the leadership half of the role, which is where most black belt projects actually fail: securing a sponsor, defining a project that can finish, managing a team the belt does not line manage, and handing over a control plan that the process owner will maintain. Delegates carry a project through the programme.

What you will learn

- Lead a project through the full improvement cycle
- Conduct measurement system analysis and capability studies
- Apply hypothesis testing and regression to process data
- Design and analyse experiments to identify significant factors
- Build a control strategy the process owner will sustain
- Secure a sponsor and define a project that can actually finish
- Lead a team you do not line manage
- Coach yellow and green belt practitioners
