Blockchain Architecture and Network Design

5 day course

Course overview

A technical course on designing and operating a distributed ledger network. Delegates work through node architecture and topology, consensus selection against throughput and finality requirements, data modelling on chain and off chain, smart contract design and its failure modes, key management and identity, and the interoperability problem between networks. Substantial attention is given to what breaks in production: chain reorganisation, contract upgrade paths, gas and throughput limits, and the operational reality that an immutable ledger makes a bug permanent. The course assumes delegates are comfortable with systems architecture and are evaluating or building a network rather than learning the concept.

What you will learn

- Design node architecture and network topology for a stated requirement
- Select a consensus mechanism against throughput, finality and trust assumptions
- Decide what belongs on chain and what must stay off it
- Design smart contracts with upgrade paths and failure modes considered
- Architect key management, identity and access for a permissioned network
- Assess interoperability options between networks
- Plan for the operational realities of running a ledger in production
