Mine Ventilation and Environmental Control

5 day course

Course overview

Underground ventilation delivers breathable air, removes contaminants and controls heat, and it is frequently the single largest consumer of power on an underground mine. This course covers designing and operating it. Delegates work through airflow fundamentals and network analysis, fan selection and duty, and the control of dust, diesel particulate, gases and radiation. Heat and humidity receive detailed treatment, since refrigeration becomes a dominant cost as depth increases across the region's deeper mines. Ventilation on demand and energy optimisation are covered alongside survey and measurement technique, and the course closes on emergency ventilation, refuge chambers and escape planning.

What you will learn

- Apply airflow fundamentals and carry out ventilation network analysis
- Select fans against duty and assess system resistance
- Control dust, diesel particulate, gases and radiation
- Manage heat and humidity, including refrigeration where required
- Conduct ventilation surveys and interpret the measurements
- Apply ventilation on demand and reduce energy consumption
- Plan emergency ventilation, refuge and escape
