Power Quality and Reliability

Course overview

Power quality problems damage equipment and stop production without ever appearing as an outage, which is why they are often diagnosed late and blamed on the wrong thing. This course covers measuring and fixing them. Delegates work through the disturbance types and their signatures, harmonics and their sources in modern nonlinear loads, voltage dips and their effect on sensitive equipment, flicker, unbalance and transients. Measurement and survey technique is taught practically, including where to place instruments and how long to record. Mitigation covers filtering, conditioning and ride through, and the course closes on reliability indices, outage analysis and building the case for an investment in quality.

What you will learn

- Identify power quality disturbance types from their signatures
- Analyse harmonics and trace them to their sources
- Assess voltage dips and their effect on sensitive equipment
- Evaluate flicker, unbalance and transient disturbances
- Plan and conduct a power quality survey that captures the problem
- Select mitigation including filtering, conditioning and ride through
- Use reliability indices and outage analysis to justify investment
