Process Plant Troubleshooting and Problem Solving

5 day course

Course overview

Plant problems are rarely solved by the first explanation offered, and the cost of acting on a wrong diagnosis is usually higher than the cost of the original fault. This course builds a structured troubleshooting method for process plant. Delegates work through problem definition, data gathering and the assessment of instrument credibility, hypothesis generation and elimination, and the use of mass and energy balances to locate a fault. Root cause techniques are applied to real plant scenarios, and the course closes on the organisational half of the problem: recording findings, implementing a durable fix and preventing recurrence rather than repeating the repair.

What you will learn

- Define a plant problem precisely enough to be solvable
- Gather data and assess whether the instruments reporting it are credible
- Generate and eliminate hypotheses systematically
- Use mass and energy balances to locate a fault
- Apply root cause analysis techniques to plant scenarios
- Distinguish a durable fix from a repeated repair
- Record findings so the next occurrence is solved faster
