Course overview

Financial technology outpaces the rules written for it, and firms operate in the gap. This course maps the regulatory position for fintech and digital asset activity, with attention to African markets where the frameworks are still forming. Delegates cover licensing and perimeter questions, anti money laundering and counter terrorist financing obligations applied to digital assets including the travel rule, consumer protection and disclosure, data protection under POPIA and comparable regimes, and the supervisory expectations for outsourcing and cloud. The course also addresses regulatory engagement and sandboxes as a practical route for a firm operating ahead of the rules.

- Determine whether an activity falls inside a regulatory perimeter
- Apply anti money laundering obligations to digital asset activity, including the travel rule
- Meet consumer protection and disclosure expectations for financial technology products
- Comply with data protection obligations under POPIA and comparable regimes
- Address supervisory expectations for outsourcing, cloud and third party risk
- Engage a regulator constructively and use a sandbox where one exists
- Track regulatory direction across the African markets a firm operates in
