Regulatory Change Management

Course overview

Regulations change continuously across every jurisdiction an organisation operates in, and the usual arrangement is that somebody notices when a deadline has already passed. This course replaces that with a process. Delegates work through horizon scanning and the sources worth monitoring, impact assessment that identifies which business processes and systems a change actually touches, and the implementation plan that follows. Ownership and accountability are covered, since regulatory change fails when it belongs to compliance alone. Tracking, evidence and the demonstration of compliance to a regulator follow. Multi jurisdiction operation is addressed. The course closes on the backlog of changes never implemented, which most organisations carry and few acknowledge.

- Assess which processes, systems and documents a change touches
- Plan and sequence implementation with named owners
- Move accountability beyond the compliance function
- Track changes and evidence compliance to a regulator
- Operate across multiple jurisdictions with differing timelines
- Surface and clear the backlog of unimplemented changes
