SAP EWM: Extended Warehouse Management

5 day course

Course overview

Extended warehouse management models a warehouse in far more detail than the inventory module it replaces, and that detail is what makes it powerful and what makes a badly configured implementation unusable. This course covers working with it properly. Delegates work through the warehouse structure of storage types, sections and bins, and the master data that drives every movement. Inbound processing from notification through putaway is covered, then outbound from delivery through picking, packing and goods issue. Internal movements, replenishment and physical inventory follow. Wave and resource management are addressed. The course closes on radio frequency operation, exception handling and the reports a warehouse manager actually uses.

What you will learn

- Navigate the warehouse structure of storage types, sections and bins
- Maintain the master data that drives warehouse movements
- Process inbound deliveries from notification through putaway
- Process outbound deliveries through picking, packing and goods issue
- Run internal movements, replenishment and physical inventory
- Use wave and resource management to sequence work
- Operate radio frequency transactions and handle exceptions
