Time, Stress Management and Prioritisation

Course overview

Most time management fails because the underlying problem is not technique but too much work and no agreed basis for choosing between competing demands. This course addresses both halves. Delegates work through prioritisation against actual objectives, the discipline of declining or renegotiating work, planning that survives interruption, and the management of attention rather than merely hours. The stress material is practical: recognising your own early warning signs, the physiological basics, recovery, and the distinction between pressure that improves performance and load that degrades it. Delegates leave with a working system rather than a list of tips.

What you will learn

- Prioritise against actual objectives rather than urgency alone
- Decline or renegotiate work without damaging relationships
- Plan in a way that survives interruption
- Manage attention rather than counting hours
- Recognise your own early warning signs of overload
- Apply recovery deliberately rather than opportunistically
- Distinguish pressure that helps from load that degrades performance
